US EPA simplifies residential pesticide labels:

The US EPA has proposed simplified labelling of outdoor residential pesticides to prevent contamination of the environment, particularly water. The optional alternative statements are intended to replace label wording that was originally devised for agricultural products. The revised statements eliminate unfamiliar terms, such as "equipment washwater or rinsate", and are targeted at specific formulation types. Four different statements have been drawn up for liquid concentrates, broadcast granules, dusts and liquid ready-to-use formulations. The proposals were developed following an initiative by the multi-stakeholder Pesticide Program Dialogue Committee. They are open to public comment until November 2nd.
